

## Follow up activity ideas for "I Need a New Bum"

## Talk about the story

Use these suggestions as points to talk about using your communication system. An adult can record the answers following the talk around each question, if you like. (**Adults:** remember to use the communication device, too, to model vocabulary. This will really help your student/child. If you don't know where words, that's great, you can work together to find them!).

Watch the story again if needed and talk about...

1. Ross Kinnaird, who drew the pictures for the book, is very good at drawing expressions to show how the characters are feeling. Look at the faces of the characters in the story. How do you think each character is feeling? How do you know? Did you find the following feelings?

- 2. Choose your favourite bum from the book and say why you think it's the best bum. You can watch the story and tell someone to"stop" when you get to your favourite!
