


USING CORE WORDS IN EVERYDAY ACTIVITIES



PLAY A BOARDGAME

Great fun for all the family and no need for a shop brought game if you don't have one. If you want to make this a more active game, how about drawing a snakes and ladders game in chalk in the driveway. Or on a rainy day you can draw your own snakes and ladders creation on a large piece of cardboard.

CORE	People/thing words	I, it, he/she, we, you/your
	Action words	Look, go, wait, turn, want, stop,
	Position words	In, up, down, off, on, here, there
	Quantity words	More, again
	Describing words	Happy, sad, finished, all gone, good, bad, same, different, like
	Question words	Who, what, where
	Other words	Problem
WAYS TO USE THE WORDS		Your turn, my turn, go up, go down, who's turn, where do you go? Go here, go there, wait there, wait here, I like it, turn again, want go, want stop, it's good, it's bad, it's the same, it's different, Problem!, I'm happy, I'm sad, it's finished
REASONS TO COMMUNICATE WITH THESE WORDS		Requesting, giving directions, commenting, naming, giving options, asking questions, answering questions,
RELEVANT FRINGE WORDS		Describing words, positional words, colour words (e.g. if you have coloured counters), numbers

Remember, you don't need to find every word you are saying on the communication system, just focus on the **key** words. These are the most important words. You can still speak a 'full' sentence out loud, while pointing to symbols for the key words.


So you might say 'I like it', but just point to/press the 'like' symbol, until you feel confident to join 2 or 3 symbols together. 😭

PATHWAYS FOR DIFFERENT SYSTEMS


Different communication systems use different 'pathways' to find the words.

Below are some of the pathways for commonly used communication systems.


77 symbol core board




TouchChat (60 button basic setup)



Proloquo2Go (60 button setup)




LAMP Words for Life




PODD (12 symbol per page expanded book)


To get to the 'game' activity page, follow this pathway:
