



Follow up activity ideas for 'Jokes'

Read/Watch the Story together

Focus on interaction

Use these suggestions as points to talk about using your communication system. An adult can record the answers on the worksheet following the talk around each question.

(Adults: remember to use the communication device to model vocabulary)

Watch the story again if needed and talk about...

- 1. What's your favourite part of the story?
- 2. What are some other types of animals?
- 3. Joking makes me feel...
- 4. Would you like someone to playa joke on you? Why/Why not?

Joke theme activities and stories (great for talking about!)

Other activities

Funny faces:

Make a funny face on a camera or in a mirror. Choose your favourite one and teach everyone how to make the funny face!

Or

Have a contest with a buddy! Make the funniest faces you can! The person who makes their buddy laugh first wins!

Funniest Moments:

What is the funniest thing that has ever happened to you? Think of a funny joke, funny story or something that looks silly. Share your story or picture with others!

Silly Furry Friends:

Anyone who has a dog, or a cat knows that animals can be a great source of joy and laughter. Have a look at some funny animal pictures online and choose your favourites. Describe the photo to someone and then show them the photo to have a laugh together!

Silly fill in stories:

Write a short funny story together! All you need to do is choose some random silly words together (without reading the story). Add them into the story and read it together. How funny is your story?
