


USING CORE WORDS IN EVERYDAY ACTIVITIES

PAINTING NAILS



CORE	People/thing words	I, me, you, we
	Action words	Come, do, feel, get, give, go, help, like, look, open/close, put, say/tell, sit, stop, take, turn, wait, want
	Position words	Here, there, on, away, in , out, off
	Quantity words	All, some, more, again
	Describing words	All done/finished, bad, different, clean, fast, good, happy, little, more, same, silly, slow
	Question words	Who, what, where, how
	Other words	Problem!, now, again
WAYS TO USE THE WORDS		Come here, sit down, I want do, I want put, give me/you, my turn/your turn, I like it, open/close it, put away, tell me, now wait, go again, take it off, put it on, go slow, looks different, ready now, looks good, looks the same, clean it up, put in there, finish it
REASONS TO COMMUNICATE WITH THESE WORDS		Give directions/instructions, request colours, request patterns and styles, make jokes, describe the end result, comment/give your opinion, ask and answer questions, protest/reject (not like that!)
RELEVANT FRINGE WORDS		Colours, describing words, people, body parts


Remember, you don't need to find every word you are saying on the communication system, just focus on the **key** words. These are the most important words. You can still speak a 'full' sentence out loud, while pointing to symbols for the key words.

So you might say 'I like it', but just point to/press the 'like' symbol, until you feel confident to join 2 or 3 symbols together.


PATHWAYS FOR DIFFERENT SYSTEMS

Different communication systems use different 'pathways' to find the words. Below are some of the pathways for commonly used communication systems.


77 symbol core board




TouchChat (60 button basic setup)




Proloquo2Go (60 button setup)






LAMP Words for Life
